How Do Societies Measure time?

As part of our exploration of our first unit, you will create a timeline of your life. Make sure your timeline reflects the criteria listed below.

- 12"x18" sheet of paper
- all materials fit within the paper
- work goes from top to bottom or left to right
- 10 events from your life
- 3 events that occurred in your immediate family prior to your birth
- each event has a date and a brief description
- each event has a visual
- events are organized and space on paper is used well
- neat and creative
- reflects effort
- final draft is in ink and includes color

You will have part of one class period to brainstorm and make notes of what you will put on your timeline. You will have one class period to create your timeline. I will provide you with all the materials you will need, the assignment is due at the end of that period.

You will be given time to reflect on your ability to complete a task according to the criteria. We will also explore how our society measures time and connect this back to your timeline.
